Christmas Buttonholes

The color given is just a guideline; please try using your own colors.




INFORMATION

This design has been digitized for the following button sizes:

7mm (1/4 inch)
9mm (3/8 inch)
11mm (7/16 inch)
12mm (1/2 inch)
14mm (9/16 inch)
16mm (5/8 inch)
19mm (3/4 inch)
22mm (7/8 inch)

-  When using a thick button, use a design that is approximately 2mm larger than the button. For example, when using a thick 9mm button, use the 11mm buttonhole.
-  If the size you need is not included in this set, use the next largest size. For example, if you have a 20mm button, use the 22mm buttonhole.

TIPS

-  When sewing buttonholes, make sure your fabric is stabilized.
-  Before you cut the buttonhole slit, apply a small amount of "Fray Check" to the back of the buttonhole along the slit.
-  To cut the slit, use a sharp X-Acto knife or cutting tool. Start at the top of the slit and cut towards the center, then turn the buttonhole around and do the same thing to the other end. This will help ensure that the buttonhole threads are not accidentally cut.
