Puzzle Quilt Assembly

Thank you for purchasing designs from My Fair Lady. Please print and read these instructions. The following instructions are for a quilt with half of the puzzle pages used on the quilt front and the other half used on the quilt back. Other quilt suggestions are shown on page 4.

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SUPPLY LIST:

- Size 80/12 Universal sewing needle
- Sewing and bobbin threads
- Fleece, flannel, chenille, or other soft fabric
 - 6"x6" pages: 1 yd of 60" wide fabric
 - 7"x9" pages: 1¼ yds of 60" wide fabric
- **Please note:** If fabric is less than 60" wide or you do not use the layouts suggested below, you will need extra yardage.
- Rickrack, pom-pom fringe or other trim
 - 6x6 pages: 4 yds
 - 7x9 pages: 5 yds

7"x9" Puzzle Pages: 30"x47"

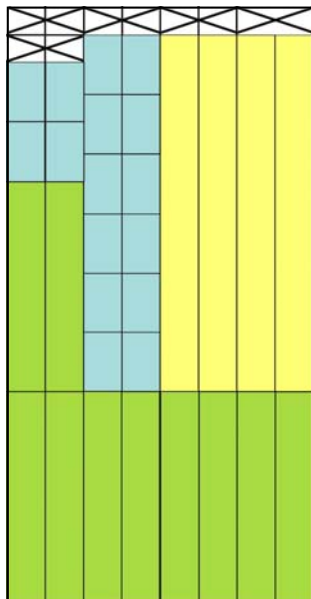
Puzzle Quilt Assembly

1. Cut the following pieces for the quilt size you are making. A suggested layout for 60" wide fabric is given.

6"x6" Puzzle Pages

(made from the 4x4 designs)

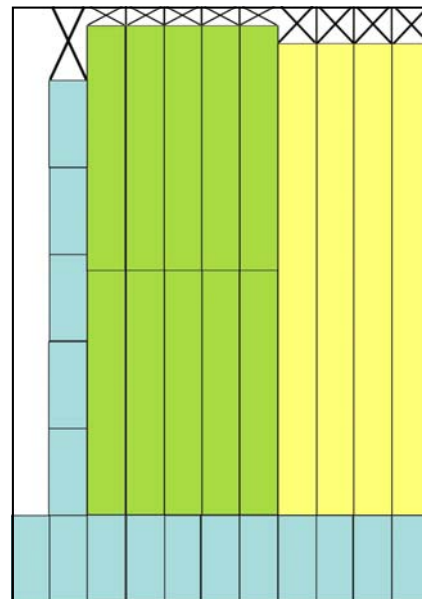
- 16 - 4"x6" strips (shown in blue)
- 10 - 4"x22" strips (shown in green)
- 4 - 4"x36" strips (shown in yellow)



7"x9" Puzzle Pages

(made from the 5x7 designs)

- 16 - 4"x9" strips (shown in blue)
- 10 - 4"x25" strips (shown in green)
- 4 - 4"x48" strips (shown in yellow)



Puzzle Quilt Assembly



- To make the front of the quilt, arrange the puzzle pages for January - June in four rows of three pages as shown.

- Stitch the strips of sashing to the quilt blocks as shown. All seam allowances for this quilt are $\frac{1}{2}$ ".
- Sew all four rows in this manner.



- Sew the four rows together with sashing in between the rows.



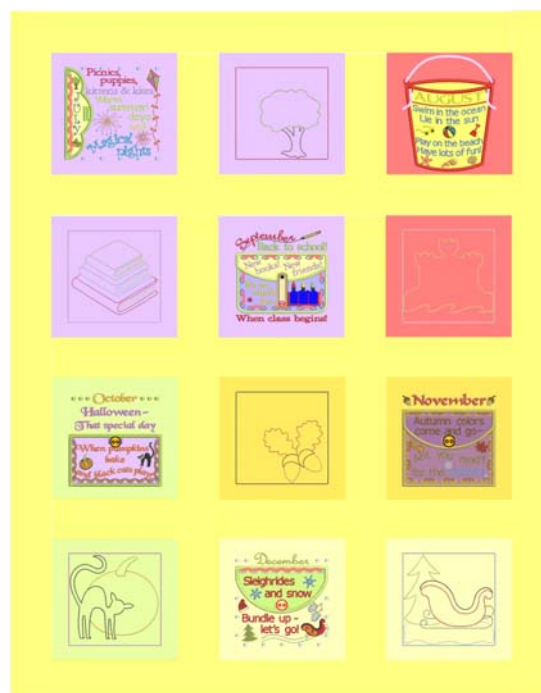
- Sew sashing to the top and bottom of the quilt.

7. Sew the two long side pieces of sashing to the quilt.

8. Follow steps 2-7 to stitch the back of the quilt with the July - December puzzle pages.



9. Baste pom pom trim, rickrack, or other trim around the edge of the quilt front.
10. Lay the quilt back on the quilt front with right sides together and sew around the edge. Leave an opening to turn the quilt right side out.
11. Turn the quilt right side out and hand-sew the opening closed.

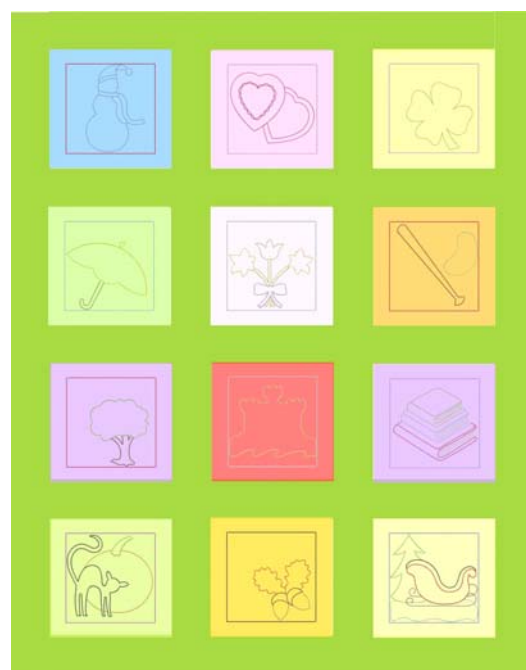
Alternate Quilt Designs

Two-Sided Quilt

This quilt is the same size as the quilt described in the instructions. Cut the same pieces of fabric.

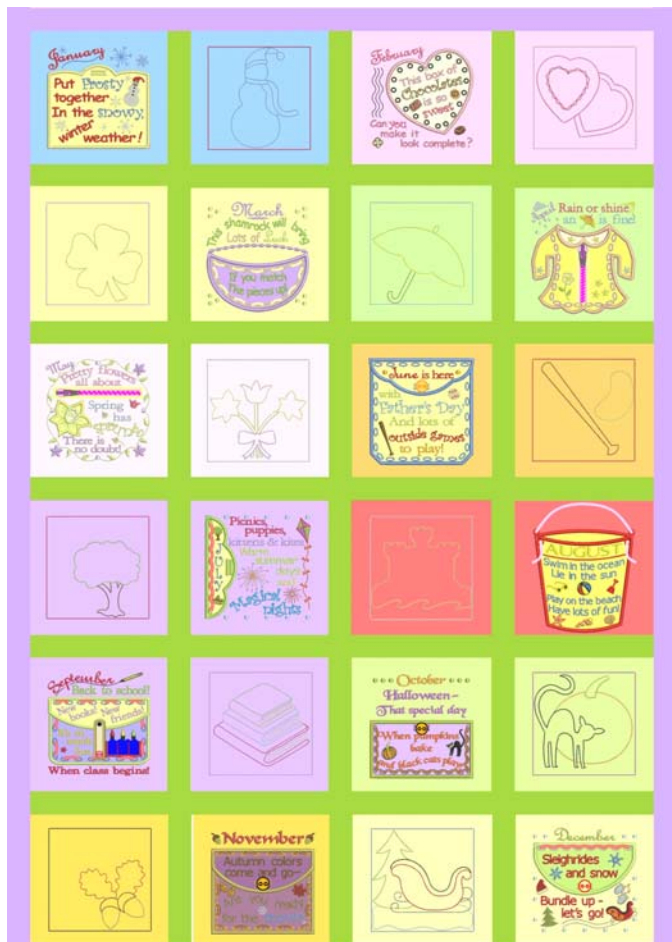


Quilt Front

(made from the 4x4 designs)
18 - 2"x6" strips
7 - 2"x24" strips
2 - 2"x38" strips
1 - 26"x38" Quilt Back
Finished Size: 25"x37"

7x9 Puzzle Pages
(made from the 5x7 designs)
18 - 2"x9" strips
7 - 2"x28" strips
2 - 2"x56" strips
1 - 38"x56" Quilt Back
Finished Size: 37"x55"

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
